

PLAYING POKER



Minimums and maximums, and maximum payouts are posted at the table.

Mississippi Stud is a poker-based game that allows you to compete against a pay table instead of a Dealer. If you have a pair of jacks or higher, you win and any pairs of 6's through 10's are a push.

Make an Ante bet to receive your first two cards.

The Dealer will place three community cards face down in the middle of the layout.

You can fold and forfeit your wager or you can play by betting one to three times your Ante on the 3rd Street.

The Dealer will then reveal the first community card.

You can fold and forfeit all previous wagers or you can play by betting one to three times your Ante on the 4th Street bet.

The Dealer will then reveal the second community card.

You can fold and forfeit all previous wagers or you can play by betting one to three times your Ante on the 5th Street bet.

Now the Dealer turns over the final community card.

Your hand will push if your five-card hand contains a pair of 6's through 10's.

Have jacks or higher? You are paid odds according to the pay table:

WINNING HAND	PAYOUT
Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	100 to 1
Four of a Kind	40 to 1
Full House	10 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Three of a Kind	3 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
Jacks or Better	1 to 1
Pair 6's to 10's	PUSH

3 Card Bonus: Mississippi Stud now features an optional 3 Card Bonus side bet that pays participating players if the three community cards contain a pair or better.
